1. Introduction

The XXX Consortium intends to secure Contracts with one or more Proponents for the provision of Student Transportation Services. Each Contract will be for a minimum term of Three Years (3) (consecutive school years), commencing on or about April 24, 2008. Each Contract shall be renewed automatically for two (2) successive one (1) year terms based on the same (except for rates) terms and conditions as contained in each Contract, unless the Consortium gives written notice to the Proponent of the Consortium's intention not to renew a Contract no later than April 1st of the fifth year of the Contract and April 1st of the first year of renewal of a Contract, if applicable.

If the Consortium does not give such written notice, the Contract shall automatically renew. All Contracts shall terminate on April 24, 2013^{vi}, unless terminated prior thereto as set out in this RFP and Model Contract.

Proposals are invited from suppliers of Student Transportation Services (the "Services") in accordance with the terms and conditions listed in this RFP, including all attached Appendices.

Model Contract

Service Objective

It is the objective of the Consortium to provide safe, efficient, reliable and economical transportation for its students. The Consortium is interested in working with Proponents who will work as partners with the Consortium to provide a level of service that is second to none.

Backgroundvii

The Consortium comprising the School Boards of XXX, YYY, ZZZ^{viii} has been working in a coterminous relationship for the past XX years. The Consortium currently retains operational staff to deal with issues unique to each Board, and a joint transportation planning unit develops and implements routing solutions. The practices and procedures to be used by the Consortium and the Proponent are noted in Article 12 of the RFP.

To ensure prompt payment of properly submitted invoices, Proponents must provide all of the information noted in Article 12.
