| SUBJECT: | CUPE Violence Prevention Training |

Letter of Understanding #15 of the Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) central terms provides that the Crown would fund the development or purchase of a training program on the prevention of violence for employees whose core duties require them to work directly in contact with students who may pose a safety risk.

The Crown retained the services of the Ontario Education Services Corporation to develop a training program on leading practices in debriefing after a critical incident.

The training program is formatted as a video PowerPoint document with live videos embedded within. Two versions are available: one is designed for use during an instructor-led presentation and the other is designed for online training. The instructor-led and online versions cover the same information about the importance and mechanics of effective staff debriefing and both are available in English and French.

Letter of Understanding #15 further provides that school boards employing education workers represented by CUPE will consult with local unions regarding the implementation of the training program.
