SUBJECT:	Amendments to 2020-21 Grants for Student Needs (GSN) Regulations and to Previous Year's GSN Regulations	

I am writing to inform you of amendments which have been made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

## Grants for Student Needs - Legislative Grants for the 2020-2021 School Board Fiscal Year regulation under the Education Act, O. Reg. 489/20

- As announced in the 2020-21 GSN Transportation Grant, a projected \$1.8M is being • provided to support the sector in addressing the Auditor General's recommendations for standardized school bus safety training. O. Reg. 489/20 is being updated so that reimbursement extends to online sessions, due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Amended the Special Incidence Portion (SIP) to allocate funding through a temporary formula-based approach rather than the existing claims-based process. For 2020-21 school boards will be allocated the higher of their 2019-20 SIP allocation, or the average of the three prior years. In addition, to help school boards manage the unprecedented challenges related to COVID-19 the ministry is also providing a one-time increase of 5%. This temporary shift to a formula-based allocation is intended to relieve school boards of the administrative work required to complete the SIP claims process.



 Reflects updated Crown contribution and stabilization adjustment funding table amount for the employee life and health trusts based on school boards' full-time equivalency reported in the 2020-21 EFIS estimates forms and the principals and vice-principals 2020-21 funding rates.

## Grants for Student Needs - Legislative Grants for the 2020-2021 School Board Fiscal Year regulation under the *Education Act*, O. Reg. 489/20 and Calculation of Average Daily Enrolment (ADE) for the 2020-2021 School Board Fiscal Year regulation under the Education Act, O. Reg. 491/20

Updated the method of calculating enrolment in secondary schools to reflect the use of
octomesters and quadmesters in scheduling of courses due to the COVID-19 pandemic,
to minimize the mixing of students and maintaining student cohorts in secondary
schools. The amendments are intended to facilitate school board counting of ADE for
the 2020-21 school year.

## Grants for Student Needs – Legislative Grants for the 2019-2020 School Board Fiscal Year regulation under the *Education Act*, O. Reg. 277/19

• Reflects the updated Crown contribution and stabilization adjustment table amount for the principals and vice principals and non-union employees' employee life and health trusts.

## Grants for Student Needs - Legislative Grants for the 2018-2019 School Board Fiscal Year regulation under the *Education Act*, O. Reg. 284/18

• Updated the Differentiated Special Education Needs Amount (DSENA) Allocation table funding amounts.

In addition to these amendments, there have also been some minor technical amendments made to these regulations.
