Subject Revised Time Limits for Renewal Funding

As you are aware, in 2023 the ministry announced the introduction of time limits on school board renewal funding allocations. Since 2015-16, the ministry has allocated approximately \$1.4 billion in funding each year to school boards to renew and improve their school facilities and sites. In making these funding commitments, the ministry expects timely on the ground improvements to benefit students and staff.

Historically, school boards have had the flexibility to carry over unspent funds from previous year allocations indefinitely. This has resulted in some school boards carrying over multiple times their annual allocation year after year. To ensure timely on the ground improvements, the ministry has amended its regulations to introduce time limits at a more accelerated pace than previously communicated.

Revised Time Limits:

- All available funds from prior school years will now expire on August 31, 2026.
- Renewal allocations for the 2023-24 school year will now expire on August 31, 2025.
- Renewal allocations for the 2024-25 school year will now expire on August 31, 2026.

Consistent with the revised timelines noted above, going forward, school boards will have two years to spend their annual renewal allocations.

Consideration for Committed Funds:

To support the completion of projects initiated before the expiry dates, the ministry will recognize funds that have been legally committed to projects. To ensure commitments are recognized, school boards will have to report the project start date, end date, and commitments in VFA Facility to facilitate this process.
