**SUBJECT:** Final 2003-04 Allocation for ISA Level 2 & 3

On July 28, 2004 you received Memorandum 2004: B-11 from Kevin Kobus with a preliminary 2003-04 allocation for ISA level 2 and 3. As promised, attached is your final 2003-04 ISA level 2 and 3 allocation based on the ministry's final baseline list of eligible files.

As you will recall, boards have had several opportunities to verify and review the accuracy of identifying information concerning claims for ISA level 2 and 3 funding:

- New 2003-04 claims were submitted by October 31, 2003.
- Enrolment Confirmation Reports of students still enrolled as of October 31, 2003 (with files eligible from 2002-03) were submitted in December 2003.
- In March 2004, each board's ISA contact received a preliminary baseline list containing file-by-file information from the 2003-04 review and the Enrolment Confirmation Reports, and was asked to provide corrections where necessary.

The Ministry has incorporated changes received from boards, compared all board responses to the Ministry's existing database of ISA files, resolved duplicates, and finalized each board's baseline of files eligible for ISA level 2 and 3 in 2003-04. In the circumstances when more than one board claimed the same student, the ISA team contacted each board to resolve where the student was actually enrolled on October 31, 2003 (the count date for all eligible files in 2003-04). The final allocation reflects these adjustments.

Your boards' final ISA 2 and 3 allocation for 2003-04, attached to this memo, will be used in the 2003-04 financial statements.

Under separate e-mail your board's ISA contact will shortly receive the baseline list with file-by-file information.

Please note that in 2004-05 there will be no portability adjustment for the movement of files eligible for ISA level 2 and 3 among boards.

As you know, ISA level 2 and 3 funding for 2004-05 will be based on your final 2003-04 results, adjusted for special education reserves and eventual allocations from the Effectiveness and Equity Fund (as described in Memorandum 2004: B-11). The government plans to reinvest funds from the Effectiveness and Equity Fund in special education over the 2004-05 school year. School board officials and representatives from trustee associations have been invited to work with the ministry on the approach to access these funds so that unmet needs can be addressed. Details will be provided to boards following this consultation process.
