SUBJECT: Provincial Consolidation - Reporting March 31st, 2005 Inter-

Organizational Balances within the Government Reporting Entity

As outlined in previous memoranda, the provincial government will be consolidating the financial information of school boards (district school boards and school authorities) in its financial statements starting with the 2005-06 public accounts. Funding was provided to school boards to assist in the implementation process.

Reporting March 31, 2005 inter-organizational balances within the government reporting entity

As part of the consolidation process for the 2005-06 public accounts, school boards (district school boards and school authorities) will be required to report on account balances that exist with other organizations within the government reporting entity ("GRE") as of March 31, 2005. This information will assist the province to determine and resolve any material differences in account balances between organizations within the GRE as of March 31, 2005 and consequently, ensure that the province's 2005-06 opening equity position is accurate. It should be noted that school boards are not asked to provide information with respect to asset or liability account balances as of March 31, 2005 that are related to transactions with organizations outside of the GRE. A listing of all organizations within the GRE is included in Appendix A of the instruction package. School boards are encouraged to contact other organizations with whom they report an account balance in order to confirm whether they are reporting the same account balance and to reconcile any differences prior to submission of the March 2005 report.

School boards should note that they are required to report an inter-organizational account balance only if it is equal to or greater than \$500,000. Detailed guidelines on materiality are included in Appendix B of the instruction package.

Management Representation

The ministry will not be requiring school boards to provide an auditors' report for the March 2005 report. However, the superintendent of business of each district school board and the secretary-treasurer or chief executive officer of each school authority must sign the management representation report, which is included in the March 2005 report package.

Due Date and Submission

The due date for submission of the March 2005 report is October 17, 2005. School boards will be reporting March 2005 information using EFIS. Instructions on creating and completing an EFIS submission for the March 2005 report as well as the detailed instructions for the reporting requirements are available through the Reporting Entity Project link at the http://tpfr.edu.gov.on.ca website.

For existing users of the EFIS "Transfer Payment" module, you will use the same userid login and password to access the "Grant Calculation" module.
