Utility Consumption Database Webinar Training for SUBJECT:

the Green Energy Act and Related Deadlines

To assist school boards in completing their *Green Energy Act's* Annual Energy Consumption and Greenhouse Gas Emissions Report, the Utility Consumption Database (UCD) provider, Aegent Energy Advisors Inc., will host two webinars for users.

The UCD automatically compiles the consumption data for all electricity and natural gas meters, and pre-populates all the facility data required to significantly reduce the administrative burden for school boards.

<u>Deadlines Related to GEA Reporting & Anticipated Timeframes</u>

- April 22, 2016 for LDCs that do not provide electronic consumption data. Boards
 must submit a photocopy of a complete energy bill for each meter to Aegent. Applicable
 LDCs: Cornwall Electric; NRG Energy; Dubreuil Electric; and Newmarket Hydro (interval
 meters). Anticipated timeframe to upload data to the UCD: four (4) weeks.
- 2. May 2, 2016 new meters and meters with significant gaps in data of more than 15 days. Boards must submit a photocopy of a complete energy bill for each meter to Aegent. Anticipated timeframe to upload data to the UCD: three (3) weeks.
- 3. May 2, 2016 completed Alternative Utilities template for FY 2015. Completed templates should be sent via email to cspence@aegent.ca. Anticipated timeframe to upload data to the UCD: three (3) weeks.
- 4. July 1, 2015 completed Annual Energy Consumption and Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reports submitted to the Ministry of Energy's online portal.
