Subject: 2023–24 Grants for Student Needs (GSN) Funding: Follow-Up

on Summer Learning Program Allocation

We are writing to provide you with additional information about the Ministry of Education's Grants for Student Needs (GSN) funding for the 2023–24 school year. As announced in the 2023: B04 memorandum, funding for the Summer Learning Program (SLP), previously provided through the Council of Ontario Directors of Education (CODE), is moving from Priorities and Partnerships Funding (PPF) into the Learning Opportunities Grant (LOG) within the GSN.

When the 2023: B04 memorandum was published, this funding was not identified in a specific allocation within LOG. Details of the 2023-24 allocation, funding methodology and enveloping are now being provided to supplement the information in the 2023-24 Technical Paper.

- The 2023-24 SLP Allocation is now projected to be \$6.0 million (up from \$5.0 million as announced in 2023: B04 and in the 2023-24 Technical Paper).
- Funding for district school boards (DSBs) will be calculated using a base amount, school board average daily enrolment (ADE) in Junior Kindergarten (JK) to Grade 6, and an

- amount to hold each school board's total to at least the same amount received in Summer 2022, as needed.
- The new SLP Allocation will be included in the Targeted Student Supports (TSS) Envelope within the LOG, allowing for flexibility between the five programs in the collective envelope. It is anticipated that school boards will use the SLP funding to ensure that they can enroll at least the same number of students in Summer 2024 as in prior years.
- The ministry will be reviewing program-based enrolment data as it becomes available to consider potential changes toward a program-based formula in future years.
- As announced in the <u>2023: SB10 2023-24 Enrolment Register Instructions</u>, reporting requirements for the SLP program have been added to the 2023-24 Summer School Register (i.e. for Summer 2024). Refer to the <u>2023-24 Enrolment Register Instructions</u> for Continuing Education Programs for more details.

Some of the elements and proposals set out in this memo can only take effect if certain regulations are made by the Minister of Education or Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Education Act*. Such regulations have not yet been made. Therefore, the content of this memo should be considered subject to such regulations, if and when made.

Summer Learning Program (SLP) Allocation

The SLP Allocation, now projected to be \$6.0 million in 2023-24, is being provided to support literacy and numeracy programs for elementary students (from junior kindergarten to Grade 6) who would benefit from additional learning support over the summer months to mitigate the impacts of learning loss.

DSBs will receive funding for the 2023-24 SLP Allocation based on the following formula:

 Base amount of \$15,000 per school board + school board's total JK to Grade 6 ADE x \$3.10 + [greater of (school board's summer 2022 SLP funding amount as set out in the GSN regulation¹ - \$15,000 - school board's total JK to Grade 6 ADE x \$3.10) or \$0]

TSS Envelope

The SLP Allocation is located within the TSS Envelope. There is flexibility in how school boards may use the five individual allocations within the TSS Envelope, as long as the funds in total are spent on the five programs in the envelope, including the SLP Allocation. For example, the SLP Allocation can be supplemented through other allocations in the TSS Envelope to support students in Grades 7 and 8, through the Literacy and Math Outside the School Day Allocation.

Use of the full SLP allocation will ensure no reduction in SLP spaces available to students relative to prior years. School boards that did not previously participate in the SLP will have the opportunity to explore how the program's proven benefits can support students.

Isolate Board School Authorities Funding

Isolate board school authorities will receive funding for the 2023-24 SLP Allocation based on the following formula:

• Base amount of \$15,000 per elementary isolate board school authority
