Estimates/Revised Estimates

The goal of the Data Verification (DV) process is to verify asset and occupancy data to support determination of grants and school level funding for 2023-24 Financial Statements and 2024-2025 Estimates/Revised Estimates and lists of eligible schools.

The Ministry will provide School Boards with three excel templates and instructions on how to complete them (Temporary Assets, Data Verification and Room Details).

The templates and instructions will be available in the Education Financial Information System (EFIS) <u>File Download Portal (FDP)</u> under the 2024-25 Estimates folder as explained in the <u>FDP User Guide</u>.

School boards are requested to review and submit the completed excel templates via email to EICCU.EDU@ontario.ca by their respective deadlines. (See Table 1 below). The verified lists must be confirmed by the board's senior business official and senior planning official by signing and dating the "Signature" sheet provided in each template.

School boards are reminded that not submitting correct data via the outlined DV process may impact school-based funding calculations, which includes the following:

- Temporary Accommodation Allocation
- Top-up component within the School Operations and School Renewal Grant (which also indirectly affects funding through the Declining Enrolment Adjustment);
- School Foundation Grant;
- Supported Schools Allocation;
- Actualisation linguistique en français Allocation; and
- Curriculum and Assessment Implementation Allocation.
