


### Response

If the Smart View tab is not visible, it is likely due to the add-in being disabled.




## **Enabling Smart View**


To Enable the Smart View Add-in Select --> File --> Options



Select Add-ins → Manage: COM Add-ins (from Dropdown menu) and click GO, then OK.




#### Check the Oracle Smart View for Office box and select --> OK




After clicking **OK** you will be returned to the previous page.


Select Add-ins → Manage: Excel Add-ins (from Dropdown menu) and click GO, then OK.

Restart Excel and the Smart View menu item will return indicating the **Smart View Add-in** is enabled.




### **Disabling Smart View**


If Smart View is enabled it will appear as follows:




### To disable the Smart View Add-in Select --> File --> Options



### Select Add-ins → Manage: COM Add-ins (from Dropdown menu) and click GO, then OK.




#### Un-Check the Oracle Smart View for Office box and select --> OK




After clicking **OK** you will be returned to the previous page.
